About a year ago, Zaffar started experiencing problems with his vision. Because of his diminished sight, they took away his driver's license and his only way to feed his kids. Zaffar was left unemployed, desperate, and with no options. After cataract surgery, Zaffar was all smiles as he felt an overwhelming sense of relief. He can provide for his family once again....He has his life back.


